In case the supplier is unable to provide a deduction at source certificate (for the withholding tax), the tax will be deducted in accordance with Palestinian law and paid on behalf of the supplier to the Ministry of Finance in Ramallah according to Law No. (8) of 2012 concerning tax deduction at source, issued by the Minister of Finance.

Kindly note that the organization will transfer payments only to the company's bank account, and under no circumstances will payments be transferred to an individual account, even if it belongs to the company owner or the authorized manager. Therefore, it is required that the company submitting the tender has a bank account under the company's name.
