Covid-19 Response

In response to the COVID-19 crisis, the IRC has adapted a 100% remote service delivery model, and is meeting urgent client needs through virtual one-on-one assistance to vulnerable low-income refugees and immigrants.

The IRC in Northern California continued with one-on-one case management and offered services in digital inclusion, food security, employment services, and financial wellbeing. We provided access to public benefits, COVID cash assistance and enhanced immigration services.

We ensured equitable digital access. In addition to providing over 100 free devices to clients, we have developed an extensive in-language digital literacy training library, available in a range of relevant languages.

The IRC in Northern California is ready to welcome new arrivals in 2021 and the coming years. Thank you for standing by us.
