How You Can Help

The International Rescue Committee creates opportunities for immigrants, refugees, and asylees to recover and establish successful new lives. Through a network of holistic programs and services, the IRC in NJ assists over **3,000 clients** annually. Here are ways **you** can get involved to help support our newest arrivals.

Internship & Volunteer Program

Year-round, volunteers are needed to assist as community interpreters, English language tutors or teachers, and professional mentors. Volunteer opportunities are also available to assist with housing set ups and transportation orientation. Students actively enrolled in undergraduate or



graduate level studies are encouraged to apply for semester or year-long internships beginning September, January and May.

Co-Sponsorship Program

The Co-Sponsorship program pairs faith-based and community groups with refugee families to assist with apartment setups, provide financial support and offer community orientation and mentorship over 6-12 months.

Hire Refugees

Refugees' determination to build a better future is an employer's advantage. IRC supports local employers to assess and screen entry-level through professional candidates.

House Refugees

If you have a private, separate space such as a guesthouse or rental apartment, please consider signing up for the Airbnb.org Open Homes program, where you can list your space for no cost.
