







Land arrivals from the Balkan route in Trieste (Italian-Slovenian border)

Single adult men

The majority come from Afghanistan (51%). On the rise compared to the past is the presence of single adult Bengali men, for the first time the second nationality of arrivals. 80% of them intend to seek asylum in Trieste.

An average of **14 new single** adult men were reached each day

Unaccompained Children (UAC)

out of the total

89% of UAC come from Afghanistan. Only 1 out of 20 intend to remain in Trieste and enter the reception for unaccompanied minors. The top 3 declared destinations are Germany, France and Switzerland.

An average of **2 new UAC** were reached each day

Family Units

out of the total

representing **58** individuals (including **25** children)

47% of families are from Afghanistan, 21% from Turkey (predominantly Kurdish ethnicity), and 19% from Syria. No families stopped in Trieste to seek asylum.

An average of **2 new members of family units** were reached each day

30 Single adult women

5% out of the total

70% of single adult women are from **Nepal**, followed by **Sri Lanka** and **Iran**. None have stopped in Trieste to seek asylum. All are in transit to other countries, primarily Portugal.

An average of 1 new single adult women was reached each day
