







People arriving from the Balkan route in Trieste (Italian-Slovenian border)

Single adult men

51% out of the total

The main countries of origin are **Afghanistan** (45%), **Pakistan** (16%) and **Syria** (12%).

36% of single adult men declared they intended to seek asylum in Trieste (320 people).

An average of **30 new single adult men** were reached every day

Unaccompanied Children (UAC)

20%

out of the total

The main countries of origin of UACs encountered were **Afghanistan** (50%), **Syria** (34%) and **Egypt** (14%).

81% declared they were traveling, with main destinations Germany, Switzerland and France. Only 7 UACs asked to enter the reception circuit for unaccompanied children in Trieste.

An average of 11 **new UAC** were reached every day

Family Units

26%

out of the total representing **459** individuals (including **252** children)

70% of the families are from **Turkey** and are predominantly ethnic Kurds, 24% from **Syria**. 12 single-parent families met. In 60% of the cases, families reported they were traveling to other countries (86% in Germany) and in 38% of the cases they chose not to share their destination.

An average of 2 **new family unit** was reached every day

Single adult women

3% out of the total

44% of single adult women are from **Nepal**, the other main nationalities are **India** and **Sri Lanka**. Only 3 women said they intended to stop in Trieste to apply for asylum. 55% said they were traveling, with the main stated destination being Spain.

An average of 3 **new single adult women** was reached every 2 days

This snapshot shows the numbers of new migrants arriving from the Balkan route encountered by International Rescue Committee Italy and Diaconia Valdese in Trieste central station area during the reporting period. The data was gathered through individual and group interviews with people reached to provide legal orientation and first aid.
