






The main countries of origin are **Afghanistan** (47%), **Nepal** (18%) and **Bangladesh** (11%).

64% of single men declared they intended to seek asylum in Trieste (270 people), confirming the upward trend from previous months.

An average of 14 **new single adult men** were reached every day

Unaccompanied Children (UAC)

13% out of the total

Almost all UACs come from **Afghanistan** (79%) and **Egypt** (18%).

63% declared they were travelling to other countries and 36% (26 people) declared they inteded to enter the reception system for unaccompanied children in Trieste or other cities of Italy.


An average of **2 new UACs** were reached every day

16 Family Units

out of the total Representing 59 individuals (including 26 children)

The main countries of origin are **Turkey** (37%) mainly kurdish, and **Afghanistan** (27%). 2 Mothers alone with children met. 64% of the families declared they were travelling to other countries and 36% that they intended to stop and seek asylum in Trieste.

An average 1 **new family unit** was reached every other day



The main countries of origin are **Nepal** (88%) and **India** (8%).

14 single women decided to stop in Trieste and seek for asylum (54%) and 10 declared they were travelling to other countries (38%), mainly to Spain.

An average of 1 **new single women** was reached every day

This snapshot shows the numbers of new migrants arriving from the Balkan route encountered by International Rescue Committee Italy and Diaconia Valdese in Trieste central station area during the reporting period. The data was gathered through individual and group interviews with people reached to provide legal orientation and first aid. The monitoring activity is carried out during the entire daytime, and partially in the evening, of every week day of the year, and in the evening on weekends and holidays.
