






The main countries of origin are **Afghanistan** (41%), **Pakistan** (19%), **Bangladesh** (14%) and **Nepal** (10%).

50% of single men declared their intention to seek asylum in Trieste (206 people) while only 22% planned to move to other countries.

An average of 14 **new single adult men** were reached every day

Unaccompanied Children (UAC)

Almost all UACs come from **Egypt** (47%) and **Afghanistan** (43%).

Only 13 unaccompanied children (15%) declared their intention to stop in Triete and enter the reception system for UACs. The majority planned to move to other cities in Italy (44%) or to other countries (40%).

An average of 3 **new UACs** were reached every day

The main countries of origin are **Turkey** (52%) **Iraq** (13%) and **Syria** (11%). 7 single parents with children were met. The majority of the families declared their intention to travel to other countries while 7 families (13%) intended to stop and seek asylum in Trieste.

An average 1 **new family unit** was reached every day

The main countries of origin are **Nepal** (65%) and **Turkey** (19%).

9 single women decided to stop in Trieste and seek for asylum (35%) while others declared they were travelling to other countries (38%), mainly to Spain.

An average of 1 **new single women** was reached every day

This snapshot shows the numbers of new migrants arriving from the Balkan route encountered by International Rescue Committee Italy and Diaconia Valdese in Trieste central station area during the reporting period. The data was gathered through individual and group interviews with people reached to provide legal orientation and first aid. The monitoring activity is carried out during the entire daytime, and partially in the evening, of every week day of the year, and in the evening on weekends and holidays.
