The main objective of the EOI is to identify and shortlist potential service provider which has the capacity to offer an automated Fleet Management software solution in the MENA Region countries.

### Solution Requirement

The Service Provider is expected to provide a Vehicle Fleet Management Solution that is able to automate the following Processes:

#### A. Vehicle Request

The solution should be able to cover the process of vehicle request from multiple predefined users across different locations/offices/countries.

#### B. Vehicle Dispatching

The solution should have the capacity of optimizing the routing and the dispatching processes performed by the Fleet Officers

#### C. Trip confirmation / Cost allocation.

The solution should include an automated solution to confirm the start and end of the trip with the ability to capture requester(s) signature(s) and Register the Respective Charging Codes.

#### D. Vehicle Tracking (GPS)

The Solution should include options to include a Mobile or a Fixed GPS unit, the unit should be able to capture the following:

- Live tracking, preferably linked to reliable and user-friendly maps, such as Google Maps
- Driver Behavior (Speeding, harsh braking ... )
- Geo-fencing (Fixed Units)
- Panic button, (Fixed units)
- Additional features will be communicated at the RFP Process

#### E. Vehicle Inspection

The Solution should automate the Daily, Weekly and Monthly Vehicle Inspection requirements.

#### F. Vehicle Maintenance

The Solution should Track the Vehicle Maintenance records and should send notifications to admins around the prevention Maintenance Dates with the ability to upload documentation

#### G. Incident / Accident Reporting

The Solution should include an incident/ Accident Report form with the Ability to upload pictures or documentation

#### H. Reporting Functionality

The Solution should include an ability to generate reports of all measured metrics and should provide a country and regional dashboard



I. Multiple Language

The Solution should be able to support multiple languages, English, French and Arabic

J. Mobile Application

The Solution should have a mobile application that support the Android and IOS devices.

K. Data Storage

The Solution should include assurances around the Security of the Data Storage.

3. The Supplier should provide a cover letter providing information on the solution to be provided and the modules that can be covered, this would include a description if the service provider aims to utilize an existing application or develop an application tailored for IRC needs.
